

## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

**Arrowsmith Engineering (Coventry) Ltd** is based on the Bayton Road Industrial Estate in Coventry. The company was established in 1967 as a general engineering company specializing in the manufacture of components for the aerospace industries. Its manufacturing capacity is flexible and capable of producing complex parts in both low and high volumes. Parts are produced using nimonics, titanium, stainless steels, magnesium and machinable plastics, as well as standard materials. The company also has the facilities to carry out in-house dimensional and NDT testing.

The management and staff of **Arrowsmith Engineering (Coventry) Ltd** understand that these processes have an impact on the environment so the company is committed to improving its overall environmental performance through the following measures:
